### Column 1: Dwelling House

The 'Dwelling House' field refers to the number that was entered by the enumerator in column 1 of the census schedule where the enumerator kept track of the number of dwellings enumerated. 1921 Data Entry User Guide 27 In the Manual of Instructions to Officers Employed in the Taking of the Sixth Census of Canada (1921), this is explained as follows:

Numbering the dwelling houses. The first dwelling house enumerated should be numbered as "1", the second as "2", and so on until the enumeration of the subdistrict is completed. The number should always be entered opposite the name of the first person enumerated in each dwelling house and should not be repeated for other persons in the same family, or for other families if it be an apartment house.
