HOME_OWNED_OR_RENTED

Definition: Refers to whether the respondent owns or rents his/her home. A home is to be classed as "owned" if it is owned wholly or in part by the head of the family living in the home or by the wife of the head, or by a son, or a daughter, or other relative living in the same home with the head of the family. It is not necessary that full payment for the property should have been made or that the family should be the sole owner. Every home not owned, either wholly or in part, by the family living in it should be classed as rented, whether rent is actually paid or not.
